- 17:00- President Bob Jenkins(Northwestern High) opened the Summer Clinic of the SCTCCCA.
- 17:13- Pete Ayoub(executive director, SCHSL) discuss concerns and rule changes for the coming year.
- 17:50- Coach LF Sanders(Allendale-Fairfax High) read the minutes from the winters' clinic and treasurers report. At that time we had \$5022.19. It was moved by John Jones(Spring Valley High) to accept the report, and seconded by Larry Bost(Lexington High). It pass by voice vote.
- 18:02- Willie Wooden(Riverside High) presented the SCTCCA COY awards for track:  
Larry Clark(Hanna High) boys' 3A; Brenda Cooper(Green Sea-F High) girls' 1A; Jody Mathis(Barnwell High) boys' 2A; Tom Morris(Spring Valley High) girls 4A; Chuck Parker (Hanna High) girls' 3A; Rob Rhodes(Landrum High) boys' 1A; Devon Smith(Ninety Six High) girls' 2A; Steve Wilson(Summerville High) boys' 4A.  
Note: Jim Crawford(Crescent High) received his COY for 2A Cross Country. Coach Clark was not present to receive his award, but Coach Parker took it in Coach Clark's absence.
- 18:06- Presentation of State Record Awards. Ms Monique Hennigan set two state records this past spring: 200m and 400m dashes. Monique was not able to attend the clinic due to the fact she just got back from the World Junior Championships; however, her mother was present(how many parents would had done that?) to graciously accept the awards.
- 18:11- Ron Sullivan(Belton-HP High) and Jack LeGrand(Chapin High) conducted the Shrine Bowl Run election for coach. Ted Whitaker(Hilton Head High) went over the cross country calendar.
- 18:20- President Jenkins pass out the ballots for election of officers to serve for the next two years.
- 18:36- It was announce that Ed Boeke(Eastside High) will assist Coach LeGrand for this year's Shrine Bowl Run.
- 18:39- President Jenkins spoke on the National Track Coaches Association.
- 18:40- David Pratt(Stratford High) went over his research on state records based on classification. Any changes, updates, etc., needs to be address to him.

18:45- President Jenkins led a short discussion on the 400m hurdles. This race will be run starting in 1995.

18:46- President Jenkins presented three proposals for determining the team championships for State finals.

Proposal 1= Leave as is

Proposal 2= Have 4 districts with 4 teams. Each district would send a team to the State finals. (A quad meet)

Proposal 3= Dual-head to head.

Proposal 2 and 3 would have an open meet for the individuals.

Vote: Proposal 1= 55; Proposal 2= 2; Proposal 3= 2.

In a clear majority, the SCTCCCA wants the State Championships for determining the team champion as it currently has<sup>e</sup> being doing since 1913.

19:16- Under "new business", President Jenkins stated that Coach Wooden will do rankings for cross country. The following were announced as the new slate of officers:  
VP: Ed Boehmke, David Pratt, and Willie Wooden.  
President: Rut Dingle.  
The winter clinic date and site was set:  
28 January, 1995, 10:00, HSL office, Columbia, SC.
