- 16:15- President Pratt open the summer clinic of the SCTCCCA.
- 16:18- The minutes were read by LF Sanders(Allendale-Fairfax High). It was approved by Carl Baker(Sumter High) and seconded by Larry Bost(Lexington High). The association has \$5,576.83.
- 16:20- Richard Robbins(West Florence High) gave out the COY awards for 1997 track season:  
Boys' 4A= Al Dunn, Sumter High; Boys' 3A= Nathaniel Jones, Southside High; Boys' 2A= Doug Blosser, Abbeville;  
Boys' 1A= George Johnson, Ben Lippen High; Girls' 4A= Mike Moore, Irmo High; Girls' 3A= Cathy Lempesis, Ridge View High(absent- too busy training); Girls' 2A= Zeke Goode, Emerald High; Girls' 1A= Steve Phillips, Johnsonville High(absent- pick up by Harris Avant, Johnsonville High).
- 16:24- Coach Sanders presented 2 special awards:  
Rut Dingle- For serving as president of the association.  
(Rut was absent)  
Lindsey Rogers= 1. Number 1 female XC runner.  
2. Setting a new state record in the 3200m run.
- 16:28- President Pratt gave a review of the 1997 track season. There are 23 South Carolina athletes running track in the SEC. Major problem about the state meet: running people(coaches) off the infield.
- 16:33- A review of certain publication.
- 16:40- Jack LeGrand(Chapin High) gave a preview of the 1997 cross country season.
- 16:45- Jim Kilbreth(Spartanburg High) talk about the Shrine Bowl run and the picking of the asst. coach. Al Dunn (Sumter High) was voted as the the asst. coach. Coach Dunn will join head coach Delmer Howell(I hope).
- 16:50- Ed Boehmke(Eastside High) talk about the Coaches Classic for cross country.
- 17:00- Proposal: John Jones(Spring Valley High) moved that the 200m dash at all lower/upper state meets, be run as sections vs. times. Coach Dunn approved, Kevin Shaw(Spring Valley High) seconded. Yes-29, No- 27. The proposal passed by 2 votes.  
The Association then approved a measure that the State track meet be held at USC on a Saturday. This measure has the blessing of Coach Curtis Frye of USC who was present at the meeting. It was requested that President Pratt and Coach Frye meet with the HSL to iron out any problems.
